

Nearpod Instructions

To Make a Nearpod Account:

1. Click the link to visit the Nearpod Home Page: <https://nearpod.com/>
2. Click “Teachers: Sign Up for Free”
3. Input your personal information to make an account.

To COPY Nearpod Lesson to your Account:

1. Click on the Nearpod link in the Lesson Plans.
2. A screen stated that a lesson has been shared with you will appear.
3. Click on “Add to my Library”
4. After the lesson has been added to your library, you can edit the lesson by hovering over the lesson and clicking the “edit” button in the bottom left-hand corner.

To Present a Nearpod Lesson:

Nearpod has three ways to present a lesson. You may choose to do it as a “Live Lesson”, in which students will log into a computer, type in the lesson code, and follow along on their computer. You may also choose to do it in a format similar to a Powerpoint. The “Student Pace” function is for students to complete without teacher direction. Because of the structure of the lessons, it is not recommended that you use this method of presentation. ● As a Live Lesson:

- Hover over the lesson.
- Click on the button that says “Live Lesson”
- A screen will appear that has a code for students to use to log into your lesson.
- Instruct students to go to join.nearpod.com and type in the code.
- Once all students have joined, you can start the lesson.

● As a Powerpoint:

- Hover over the lesson.
- Click on the button that says “Preview” in the bottom right-hand corner
- Click on the expand button in the upper left-hand corner.
- Click “Preview” to begin the lesson.

- Use the arrow keys on the left and right of the slide to move from slide to slide.
